REFRESH: *The process of providing pastoral and lay leadership with ongoing training opportunities; producing new energy and passion to improve their personal ministry skill set. A refreshed leader brings new joy and excitement to the ministry field.*

RENEW: *The process of restoring the essentials to the church. Every church (and believer) needs to have a regular spiritual tune-up. A healthy church has emotionally and spiritually healthy leaders.*

REVISION: *The process in which church leadership discovers and defines their disciple-making mission and model. Every church has a unique God-given potential and identity.*

REVIVE: *The process in which pastoral and lay leadership enter into a formal agreement with the convention to receive training/resourcing in church revitalization. The intended focus is to get the leadership and the members of the church prepared for the restoration and revitalization work of God.*

REPLANT: *The process in which members of a church discern God's leadership to dissolve their current ministry and work with other churches or denominational bodies to begin a new church for a new season of ministry in their community.*

CHURCH REVITALIZATION: *The supernatural work of God that restores health in a church, evidenced by submission to God's Word, right relationships among members, and a renewed commitment to Great Commission ministry.*
