Position Summary:

Under the Senior Pastor's guidance, the Worship Leader has overall responsibility for Music ministries.

Key Duties and Responsibilities:

- Works weekly with Pastoral Staff to strategize Sunday morning music, flow, schedule, worship setting, stage design, volunteer scheduling, and developing first impressions team.
- Leads weekly church worship services at South Peoria Baptist Church.
- Supervises sound booth activities which includes lighting and technology teams.
- Assists in preparing the Music and Worship budget for presentation to finance committee each year.
- Leads, plans, schedules, conducts rehearsals, delegates responsibilities and appoints leaders, as needed, to lead Praise Teams, Praise Bands, Drama Ministries, Children's Choirs, Instrumental Ensembles or any additional music and/or worship groups formed at South Peoria Baptist Church.
- Oversees special events including youth and children's music camps, block parties, musicals and other seasonal events planned by the Staff and Administrative team.
- Worship ministry team administration including; music selection, training team leaders, planning, implementing long-range strategies and the development of Ministry Team concepts.

Qualifications:

- Possess and maintain a valid State of Arizona drivers license.
- Microsoft Word, Excel and Power Point proficient. (Database experience such as MS Access helpful)
- Audio / Video equipment operations and management (ProPresenter).
- Doctrinal agreement with and membership at South Peoria Baptist Church.

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:

- Strong Biblical background, prayer life and relationship with the Lord Jesus Christ for at least 5 years.
- Must possess and adhere to all Biblical qualifications for Elder/Overseer.
- Strong history of serving others in church where the Bible is the final authority in life and practice.

- Ability to sing, harmonize, read and interpret music and direct musicians.
- Must be emotionally mature. (Able to be questioned or corrected without taking offense or retaliating.)
