Responsibilities:

Worship

- Lead worship for all regular and special services for the church
- Develop worship services that encourage people of various ages, ethnicities, and spiritual backgrounds to participate in worship
- Recruit, develop, and train people to serve in the worship and tech teams
- Coordinate with the Senior Pastor in preparing worship services and planning sermon series
- Oversee all media, technology, and stage needs for the worship center
- Assist other ministry areas in securing technology to support their worship and media needs

Youth

- Lead and oversee all aspects of the student ministries for youth in grades 6-12. This includes but is not limited to the following:
 - Sunday Morning Bible Study
 - Midweek youth service
 - Camps, retreats, and other events
 - Outreach events designed to bring students to Christ
 - Fellowship opportunities for youth to build relationships
- Create a strategy to disciple students into maturing followers of Christ who can be disciples who make disciples.
- Develop and lead a leadership team for the student ministry
- Build relationships with students and their parents
- Create and manage a budget for the youth ministry
- Identify, recruit and train volunteers to serve in the youth ministry
