Primary Responsibilities and Tasks

1. Lead and organize effective programs for students that combine fellowship, biblical teaching, discipleship, and evangelism
2. shepherd all student ministry volunteers
3. Plan and execute services for students that are biblically accurate, culturally relevant, and high-energy.
4. Integrate the mission and vision of FBC Pinetop into overall family ministry goals and activities.
5. Be an active presence in our local high school with periodic visits engaging students.
6. Cast vision for, teach and plan retreats and camps with music, messages, games, and activities that inspire students to grow in their walk with Christ.
7. Set annual goals for the family ministry that align with the overall mission, vision, and church-wide goals.
8. Oversee and train nursery and support staff
9. Research, select, and coordinate biblically based, age-appropriate curriculum for Sunday School, Vacation Bible School, and other learning events
10. Develop and maintain annual budgets for all discipleship ministries.
11. Assist the Pastor as needed with the care of members and with other tasks he may delegate
